

Government decree 28/2004 about completing the tasks of the National Focal Point

Article 1 set out the existence of the National Focal Point.

Article 2

The NFP collects data and information and receives data to report yearly to the EMCDDA. The National Statistical Data Collection Program (NSDCP) contain the data collection and data acquisition for statistical purposes. The required data used by the NFP and other information listed in Annex 1 are provided by institutions in Annex 2 and all institutions under their professional control or guidance. The concerned institutions provide data and information according to NPSDC. All information and data beyond NPSDC required by the NFP must be provided, based on request, suitably for completing the tasks of the NFP and ineligible for identification of persons.

Article 3 is about the approval process of the National Report by the Ministries and the cooperation with the Drug Coordination Committee.

Annex 1

Provided information related to the tasks of the NFP:

- Information on drug users (by virtue of characteristic of the user's groups);
- Information on drug use, structural composition, availability, price and quality of drugs;
- Information on drug related treatment, other services or screening and primary, secondary prevention programs;
- Information on drug related deaths;
- Information on drug related infectious diseases;
- Information on drug related crime, imprisonment, quality and price of seized drugs;
- Information on budget and public expenditure related to the drug use;
- Information on illicit production and trafficking of drugs;
- Information on public, state and local governmental proposal for prevention and reduction of drug use.
